

Our School Won the "Best Presentation Award" at the World Robot Olympiad

Five Carmel Design and Technology students have represented Hong Kong at the "World Robot Olympiad". The event was held in Nanning, China from 16 to 19 November 2006. Lee Vincent Shing Tai (4D), Wong Ka Yiu (4D) and Lam Kwok Man (4D) receive the "Best Presentation Award" in the Open Category Secondary Division, which is among the 7 awards competed by 18 teams from 12 countries/regions. Yan But Kei (4B) and Cheung Ho Chung Rayson (4A) rank 13 out of 42 teams from 16 countries/regions in the Regular Category Junior Secondary Division. They are also the best ranking Hong Kong team.
