School Orchestra and Instrumental Classes

With holistic education as our school mission, not only do we emphasize moral and academic development, but we also actively promote various extracurricular activities, so that our students make the best use of their leisure time, enrich knowledge, acquire social skills and grow healthily. Our school orchestra has therefore been established for years and training is provided by professional instructors. Interested students can enrol by paying part of the tuition fee and those with financial needs can apply for subsidies and borrow musical instruments for practice. They can develop appreciation for music, achieve a comprehensive understanding of western musical instruments and gain fulfilment. Details are as follows:

Tuition Fee: for approximately 36 lessons (including performances and rehearsals) in the entire academic year

(i) \$3600 for joining an instrumental class (Two installments of \$1800 each)

(ii) \$1800 for only joining the symphonic band or the string orchestra (Two installments of \$900 each)

Membership Fee: \$50 for operating expenses like photocopies of musical scores and Orientation Day.

Payment Method: A circular containing the information will be given out on the interview day

Musical Instruments: Self-prepared (Students can apply to borrow a limited number of percussion instruments and brass instruments from the school but availability of those instruments is subject to conditions.)

Note: 1. This is a school team and students can choose whether to join it. Compulsory attendance for the entire academic year is required once students join it.

2. There are beginner and advanced levels for instrumental classes and students are assigned to either depending on their standards. Classes with fewer students will be combined or cancelled.

有關管弦樂校隊並訓練班事宜

敬啟者：本校向以推動全人教育為宗旨，除注重學生品格及學業培訓外，更積極推動各類課外活動，使學生善用餘暇，增進課外知識，發展群體生活，俾使全人有健康的成長。為配合此教育理想，本校特於多年前成立管弦樂團，聘請專業導師蒞校教導，同學只需繳交部份導師的費用即可參加，有經濟困難者可向學校申請學費資助及借用樂器練習，使同學能提高音樂方面之涵養，對西洋樂器有全面的認識，藉此陶冶性情，變化氣質。現將管弦樂團簡介如下：

樂 器： 自備 (敲擊樂及部份銅管樂可向學校申請借用，因數量有限，會按情況分配)

註： 1. 此乃校隊活動，可自行決定參加與否,但參加者必須全年出席。

2. 樂器班會根據學生的音樂水平分為初班及高班上課，部份人數較少的班則會合併上課或取消。
